CPR SATURDAY INFO

.....
::The Atlanta Area Council is a proud partner with the American Red Cross to provide CPR and basic first aid certifications to the Scouting community and general public. CPR Saturday happens twice every year; once in December and once in March. These certification days offer several certification levels and are open to anyone who is interested in participating.

Adult CPR & AED- A 3 1/2 hour course detailing basic CPR concepts. \$45 per person.

Standard First Aid & CPR- A 5 hour course detailing basic first aid principles and includes Adult CPR & AED certification. \$55 per person.

CPR for the Professional Rescuer- An intense 8 hour course for lifeguards, emergency medical personnel, and other professional lifesavers. \$65 per person.
