#### **Tips For Success**

- 1. Sell your first camp card to your parent/guardian(s).
- 2. Have Parents SELL Camp Cards to their colleagues at work.
- 3. Call Grandma and Grandpa! They would love to support your sale.
- 4. Participate in a store-front sell (Waffle House, grocery store, gas stations, restaurants, etc. (BE Sure that you have permission from the owner or manager!!!)
- 5. Take cards to school and ask your teachers.
- 6. Ask Parents to post on social media a picture of you in uniform requesting friends to buy cards.
- 7. Visit the police station/fire department.
- 8. Ask Pack or Troop alumni for their support.
- 9. Ask those that you support to support you! (Girl Scouts, booster clubs, clubs).
- 10. Invest 1-hour visiting neighbors asking them to support your Scouting program.
- 11. Visit local businesses to sell in their offices ---be sure to ask first you are selling outside their location hint---check with your local Waffle House

#### **Sales Techniques for Scouts**

#### Scouts, practice these simple steps:

Don't miss the opportunity to work on public speaking, sales and service.

Role play and practice. Wear your uniform

Smile and tell them who you are - first name only!

Tell them where you are from

(Troop 204, sponsored by MapleAvenue United Methodist Church).

Tell them what you are doing (earning money toward Scout Camp, campouts, Okefenokee, etc.)

Tell them what they can do to help (save money with the Camp Card).

Close the sale, and thank them.

#### How to Sell Camp Cards +++++++++++

DOOR TO DOOR: Take your SALES KIT and Cards for a trip around the neighborhood. Highlight the great coupons! SHOW & SELL: Set up a sales booth and sell CAMP CARDS on the spot.

SELL AT WORK: A great way for Mom and Dad to help their Scout. Have Mom & Dad take the SALES KIT to work.

#### **Safety and Courtesy**

- Never enter anyone's home. Never sell after dark, unless with an adult. Don't carry large amounts of cash.
- Always walk on the sidewalk and driveway. Be careful of dogs while selling. Don't talk to strangers alone.
- Say thank you whether or not the prospect buys a Camp Card.

## We're selling Scouting, not just Discount Cards, so look for opportunities to share scouting and invite someone to a troop meeting!

Remember that you are selling character, you are selling a better community, and you are selling the benefits of our program. Camp Cards can help you offset the price of Scouting.
